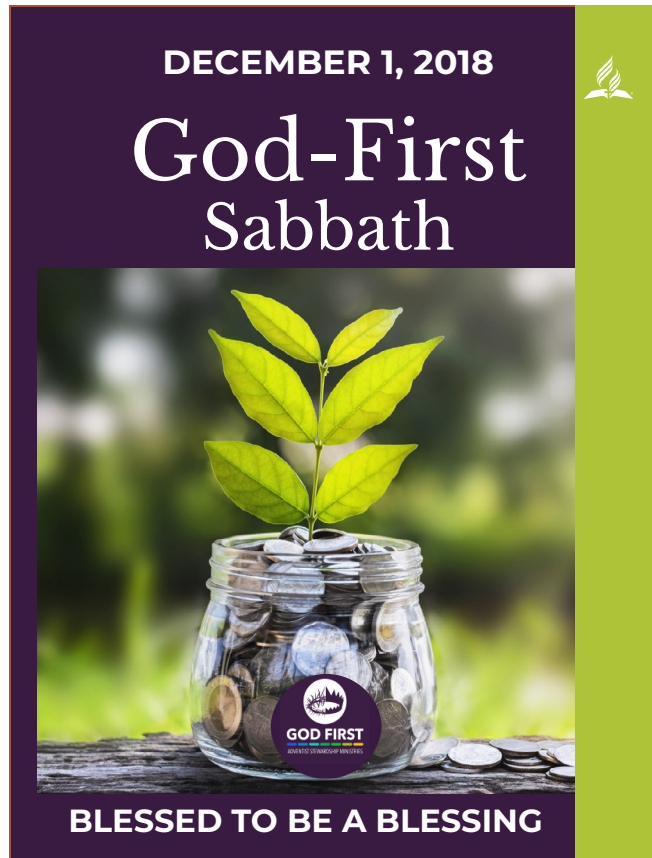

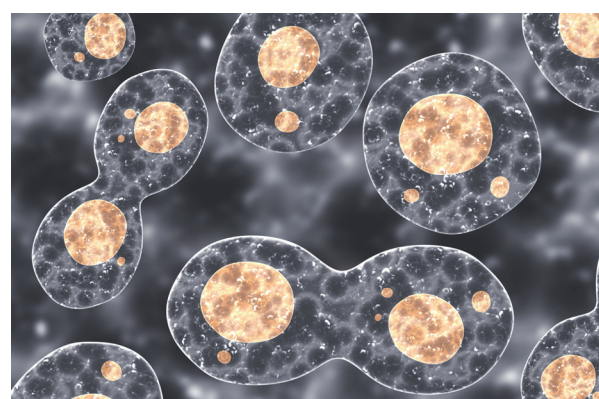


Christian and Creation Care by Dr. JoAnn Davidson

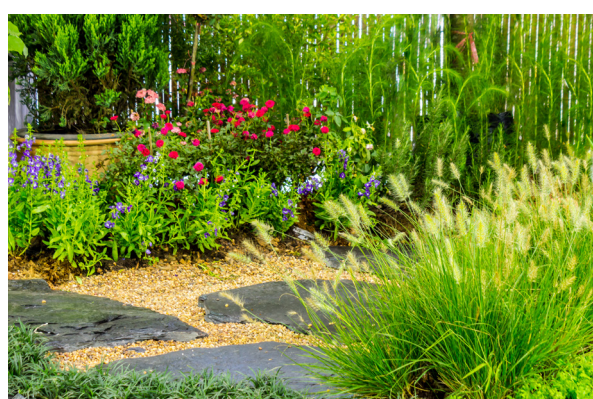
